

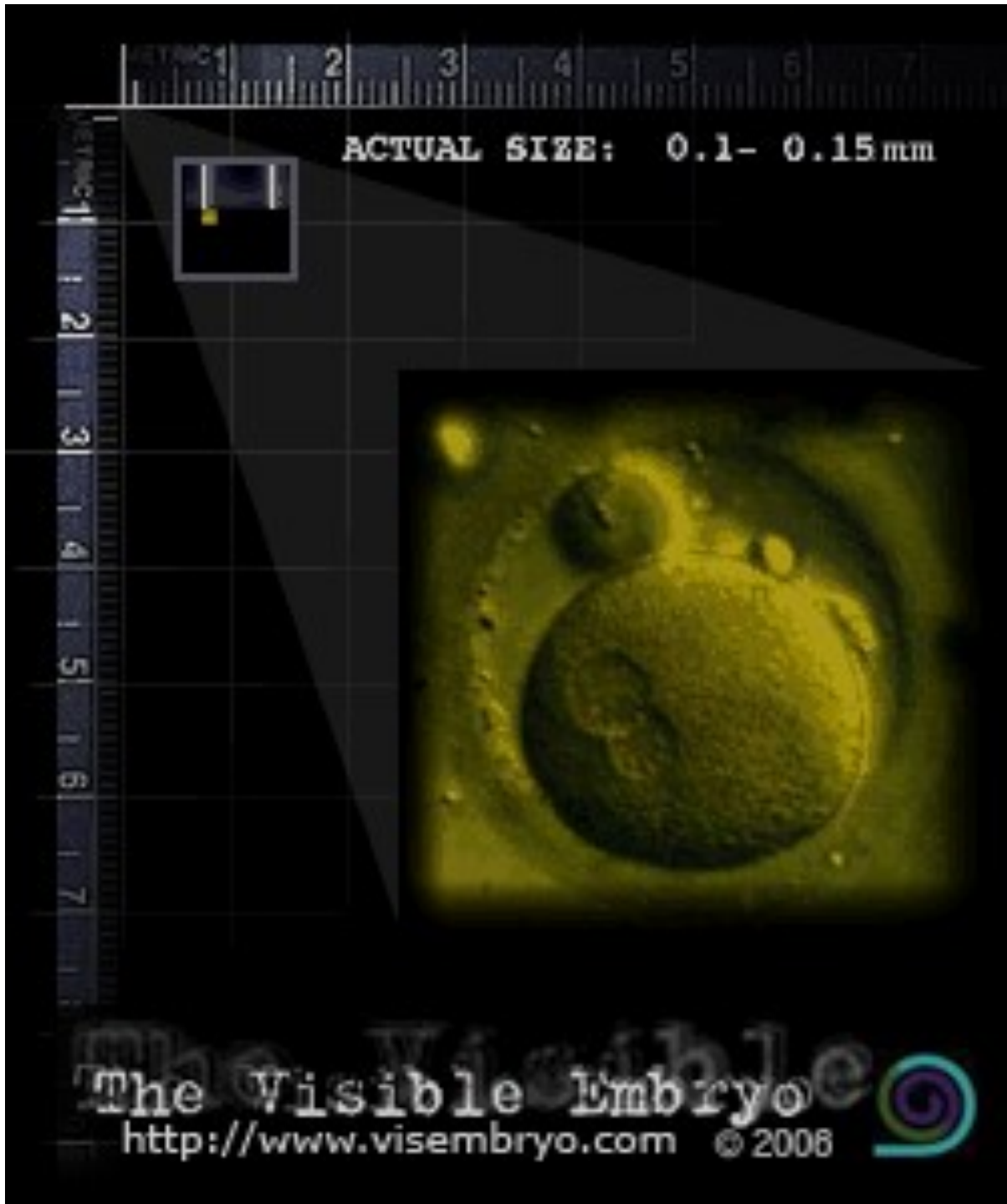
There are approximately 1.2 million abortions performed every year in the U.S — an average of $1,200,000 / 365 = 3288$ abortions per day. The following pictures depict the developing human being at various stages through pregnancy and indicate how many developing humans after the stage depicted are killed on average every day, based on statistics from the Center for Disease Control.

1 Day after Fertilization

3288 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after the first day of development.



4 Weeks after Fertilization

(earliest point for which the CDC provides statistics)

2,145 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after completing their 4th week of development.



6 Weeks after Fertilization

1,122 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after completing their 6th week of development.



8 Weeks after Fertilization

625 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after completing their 8th week of development.



10 Weeks after Fertilization

354 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after completing their 10th week of development.



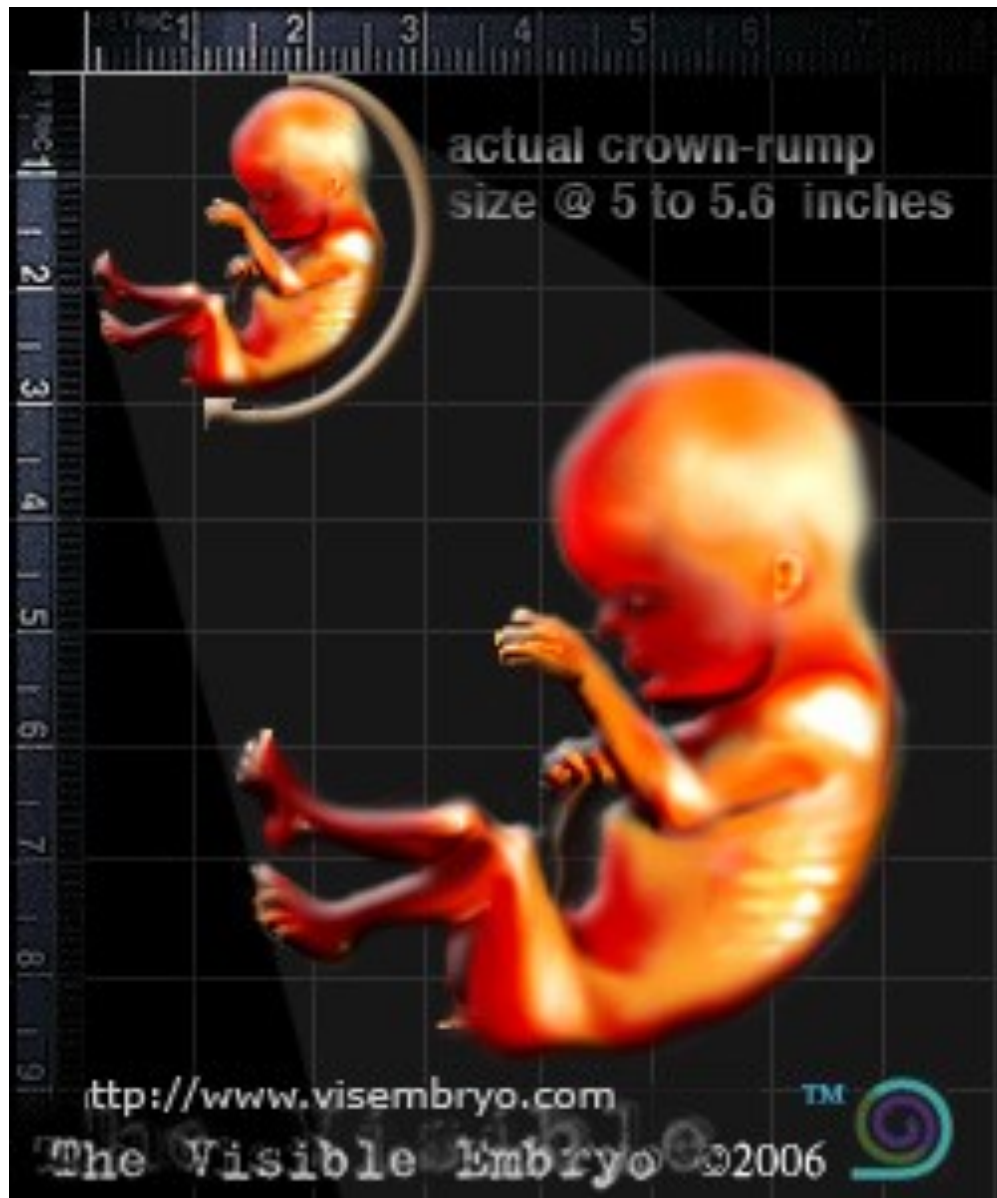
12 Weeks after Fertilization

159 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after completing their 13th week of development.



14 Weeks after Fertilization

99 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after completing their 15th week of development.



18 Weeks after Fertilization

40 developing human beings are killed by abortion every day in the U.S. after completing their 18th week of development.



Birth = (normally) 38th Week after Fertilization

There have been reports of babies being killed or allowed to die after being born at full term. It is certain that human beings that are born alive as a result of attempted late-term abortions are sometimes killed or allowed to die. No statistics have been found on these phenomena.
