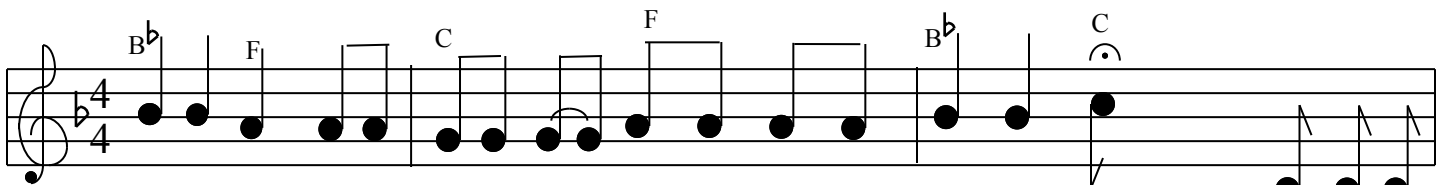
1. There's a woman who's young and full of dreams, with a secret -- things are not as it seems.

3. There are many who got rid of what they deemed a threat, but now live a life filled with pain and regret. They



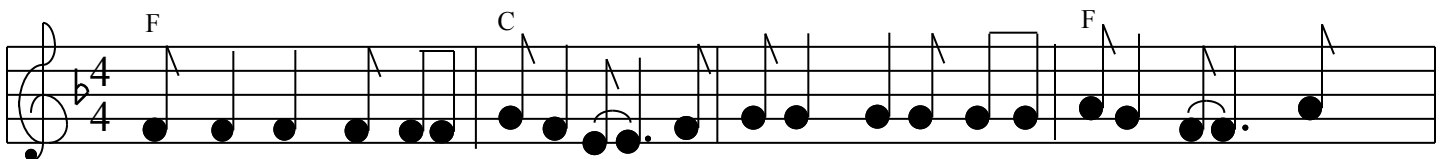

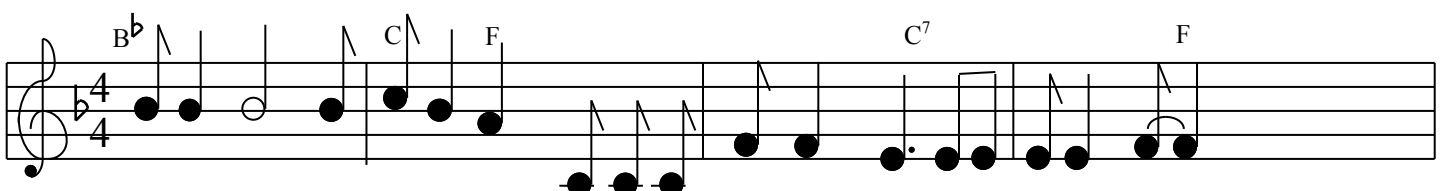
